Applicants must be self-motivated with strong interpersonal and problem solving skills, present themselves as a positive role model and mentor, and ensure the safety and supervision of the children/youth they support.

All positions require that you have your Emergency first Aid & CPR/AED Level C, own reliable vehicle with third party liability of \$1 million, a Class 5 driver's licence, and a clear Police Information Check including vulnerable sector search and will be the financial responsibility of the candidate, as well as a Child Intervention Record Check. Note: Child Intervention Record Check forms are available from Transitions and are free.)

Transitions is committed to providing a safe environment for all its employees and customers. Therefore, Transitions has implemented a COVID-19 Vaccination Policy.
